Materials List

The materials listed below will allow you to mix the first few color charts of the system during the workshop. With this knowledge and experience you will be able to create other color charts on your own.

Oil Paint- It is an advantage to have fast drying oils for this project, in particular the white, black and Van Dyke brown. The green and red do not have to be fast drying, but it is better if they are. You can also use regular oils and use Liquin as a medium to hasten drying. Never buy colors which have the word "hue" in the name. They will not tint as well as the real thing.
